# What we've been up to?

26 March -4 April 2019 EKO organised and coordinated the Erasmus+ Youth Exchange project Breaking Walls, Building Bridges, which took place in Athens. 41 young people from Armenia, Cyprus, Greece and Turkey participated in nonformal education activities that aimed to improve the problematic relations among the four countries.

In April EKO hosted 49 people from Estonia, Italy, Greece, Germany, Lithuania, Spain and Poland as part of The Erasmus+ Youth Exchange project Europe United: Facing Challenges, Reinforcing Solidarity. During 10 days of activities, the participants among others discussed challenges faced by the EU nowadays, interviewed locals about their opinions about the EU and met the representatives of the Offices of the European Parliament in Greece.

#### 2 - 5 May 2019

EKO participated in The European Youth Week by designing and organising a special Art Workshop Democracy and I, to foster social inclusion and highlight that vulnerable groups of young people constitute an integral part of a democratic society. Children and teenagers living in the Hatzikonsta Foundation for orphans and vulnerable youth, were invited to express their understanding of democracy, active citizen engagement and peace using artistic improvisation and teamwork.

In the frame of the Sustainability through Cross Border Circular Economy project, in which EKO took part as a co-beneficiary, EKO participated actively in the 3rd transnational partner meeting, monitoring the progress of the cross border circular economy project. During the meeting, partners identified major challenges faced by oenterprises operating within the circular economy.

17 - 18 September 2019 14 - 17 October 2019 EKO was honoured to have been selected by the Greek National Agency of Erasmus+ to participate in the TCA Seminar APPETIZER – An introduction on how to use the 'Erasmus+ Youth in Action' Programme for international youth work. The event aimed at creating a space, where youth worker with experience in youth events at a local level, members of organisations or informal youth groups new to Erasmus+ could explore possibilities of support available for youth activities by the Erasmus+ Program.

Under the auspices of the International Alliance for Peace and Development (IAPD), EKO organised an international youth photography competition entitled Peacemakers: Through your world I see mine, which concluded with an open photo exhibition. The 30 best photos, selected through open, international, online voting, were exhibited in Geneva in front of the UN building in November 2019.

October 2019

29 November 2019 On the occasion of the International Day of Persons with Disabilities and the International Volunteer Day, together with Tandem NGO, EKO organised a Workshop of handicrafts and creation of Christmas ornaments at K.A.A.P.B. (former PIKPA) in Voula. The workshop was designed for ten children with disabilities to create Christmas cards, bookmarks and garlands.

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In the context of our Youth Club activities, EKO's volunteers Gaia and Rosaria prepared, coordinated and implemented an Intercultural dialogue workshop on Human Rights. The event was organized in collaboration with Caritas O-Hellas. Young people from an international background participated actively in the workshops and engaged in a constructive discussion and exchange of opinions on the violation, respect and protection of Human Rights.
