What we've been up to?

January 2020

Eko represented the Greek NGO network during the visit of 40 students from the Department of Cultural Anthropology and Development Studies of Radboud University in Nijmegen. We had the opportunity to present the work of EKO, information on the resources of European programs and opportunities that are open to young people in the framework of the ERASMUS + programs and the European Solidarity Corps.



EKO concluded a cooperation agreement for the Pathways to empowerment in Gender-Based Violence prevention program, which is implemented together with civil society actors from Norway, Bulgaria, Italy, Spain, Malta, Kenya, Canada, Colombia and Uzbekistan. Within the framework of this program, EKO participated in the Kick-off meeting in Malta, where we exchanged ideas on the implementation of our joint project on strengthening the capacity of youth and youth workers in gender diversity & LGBTIQ+ rights advocacy.



January 2020

January - March 2020 EKO organised and implemented three seminars on the project Cycle Management and the Lifelong Learning, International Mobility and Volunteering opportunities that exist under the Erasmus + Programs of the European Solidarity Body and Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs. These seminars were held at the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens and the University of West Attica with a participation of more than 100 young people.



During the time of the pandemic, EKO designed, wrote and submitted 6 proposals for future projects. We have also concluded a cooperation agreement as a co-beneficiary in project proposals for 13 projects under the Erasmus + KA2 Strategic Partnerships, 1 program under the European Program Rights, Equality and Citizenship (REC), 1 program under the European Program for Business Competitiveness and Small and Medium Enterprises (COSME) and 33 programs under the Erasmus + KA1 program: International Youth Mobility.



March - June 2020



In the context of the Youth Voice: We Are Shapers, Not Listeners project, EKO conducted an online survey named Engage towards a greener future. Through this questionnaire, 230 young Greeks (15-30 years) had the chance to voice their concerns, opinions and ideas on the most important environmental problems of our times and the way towards a greener and viable future. You can find the results on EKO's website.



EKO submitted a report to the UN Special Rapporteur on the Rights of Immigrants, Felipe González Morales, following a relevant invitation open to NGOs internationally, which concerned the protection of refugee children and unaccompanied minors in Greece. The report was published on EKO's website.

May 2020

June 2020

We implemented an Open-Ended Consultation held online in the framework of the project Pathways to empowerment in Gender-Based Violence prevention, with 30 Greek participants aged 18-30. The consultation aimed at determining the appropriate training-teaching-learning methods for filling the existing knowledge gaps of young people and youth workers regarding the rights and special needs of social integration of the LGBTQI + community.


