Background and experience

Please briefly present your organization/group (e.g. its type, scope of work, areas of activity and if applicable, approximate number of paid/unpaid staff, learners and members of the group).

EKO, the Entrepreneurship and Social Economy Group, is a non-profit organisation seated in Athens, Greece, with an extended network of partners across Europe, the Euromed basin, Africa, Asia and the Middle East.

It is the founding member of the Euromed Network of Youth Organizations (Y-NEMO), as well as a founding member of the International Alliance for Peace and Development (IAPD) with members in European and MENA countries. EKO also supports the Observatory to Prevent Extremist Violence (OPEV) as an active member contributing constructively to prevent and combat violent extremism, organizing various events, info days and conferences to raise awareness on this matter.

Moreover, EKO is an active member of the network of the Anna Lindh Foundation and is honored to display the logo of the European Year of Cultural Heritage (EYCH) for two implemented Erasmus+ youth mobility projects. In addition EKO has an EVS accreditation for sending and hosting volunteers, as well as coordinating EVS projects. In the new Erasmus+ ESC context, EKO maintains this accreditation for the planning and implementation of ESC projects.

Throughout its activities, EKO maintains a special collaboration with Art and Theater Tutors, constantly expands its network of partners and collaborations in Greece and maintains and further develops a youth club with active members and activities.

In particular, the Board Members are experienced psychologists, educators, entrepreneurs, and provide services to youth, schools, universities and institutions, chambers of commerce and industry, ministries of education, culture and labor, syndicates and related associations. EKO's team consists of experienced youth workers and a culturally diverse and constantly renewed group of young volunteers, through European Programs (ESC, EYE).

EKO has planned, coordinated and implemented multiple Erasmus+ Programs, involving many partner organizations from Europe, MENA and neighboring countries on various fields of interest related to the objectives of its statutes:

"Communication Bridges for Young People" was hosted in Athens, in November 2016 with Greece, Turkey, Italy, Poland, Bulgaria, Egypt & Croatia.

"Globalization vs. Cultural Diversity", which took place in Athens in April 2018 with participants from 8 different countries (Greece, Italy, Spain, Lithuania, Czech Republic, Austria, Poland, and Turkey)

"COUNTERING VIOLENT EXTREMISM", which took place in Athens in November 2018 and involved 42 young people from 7 different countries Greece, Spain, Turkey, Jordan, Egypt, Tunisia and Italy)..

<u>"GREEN CITIES"</u> involved 62 young people from eight (8) organizations from different countries: Egypt, Georgia, Greece, Italy, Jordan, Croatia, Turkey, United Kingdom.

<u>"Europe United: Facing challenges reinforcing Solidarity"</u>, which took place in Athens, Greece in April 2019 and involved 50 young participants from 7 countries (Greece, Lithuania, Italy, Estonia, Spain, Poland, Germany)

<u>"Breaking Walls, Building Bridges"</u>, which took place in Athens, Greece in March 2019 and involved 41 young people from 4 countries (Greece, Turkey, Armenia and Cyprus)

- Development of on-line Courses and informational material on non-formal education, life-long learning, intercultural dialogue and other subjects aiming to empower youth and enhance participatory approach through civil society actions.
- Participation in Volunteer Exchange and Vocational Training programs (EVS, Leonardo, KEK placements, Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs)
- Collaboration with European Solidarity Corps volunteers and with aspiring new entrepreneurs within the framework of Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs.
- Active Participation in the European Youth Week 2017 and 2019 in collaboration with Schools and Foundations
- Mentoring of entrepreneurs in crisis (Early Warning European Project)
- Participation in Prince's Trust International Entrepreneurship Program for youth, which offers an introductory interactive Seminar (Explore enterprise course) & professional guidance/counseling for the development of a Business idea into a business plan.
