The "Training of Trainers" event, hosted by TDM2000 Malta, brought together 20 youth workers from Cyprus, Italy, Greece, Malta, and Portugal. Held in Pembroke, Malta from March 9–15, 2025, the training focused on equipping participants with skills to use sports as a tool for promoting environmental sustainability among youth.
