The STELLA Project (2024–2026), under the Erasmus+ KA2 initiative, continues to strengthen its mission of promoting environmental sustainability through sport. The consortium - comprising partners from Italy, Greece, Malta, Portugal, and Cyprus - has been actively implementing local educational activities, awareness-raising actions, and online dissemination efforts to connect young people, educators, and communities around this shared goal. Below is an overview of the latest milestones and achievements.

Local Workshops – April–September 2025

Over the past months, STELLA partners have delivered 25 workshops in the 5 countries of the partnership, engaging more than 500 young people. These sessions were inspired by the methods developed during the Training of Trainers held in Malta and focused on helping participants connect sport with environmental awareness in creative and meaningful ways.

Online Dissemination Campaign – September - February 2025

To reinforce the visibility and impact of these initiatives, the consortium launched a six months online dissemination campaign coordinated by our Greek partner, EKO. From September to February, many posts, articles and audiovisuals are expected to be published across partners' social media platforms. The campaign targets youth workers and educators, offering practical ideas and examples of how sport can promote sustainability. The campaign has already successfully sparked dialogue among youth organizations across Europe, reinforcing the project's collective effort to highlight sports as a tool for environmental education in youth work.

Upcoming Meeting: Round table in Braga and Transnational Partners' Meeting(TPM)

In December 2025, an international round table on sport, youth and environment involving 25 international stakeholders and 100 local ones will be organized in Braga, Portugal, by our Portuguese partner, Synergia. This event aims to create local and international networks on the topics, new connections and ideas for common projects

Synergia, will also host the next TPM that aims to review the progress, share results, and plan the final stages of the STELLA project, ensuring lasting impact and continued collaboration across all partner countries.
